

Once fully inserted, rotate the screwdriver counter-clockwise to eject the disc. The disc will eject from the disc slot on the front of the system. Rotate the eject mechanism until the disc is fully ejected. It may take several turns before the disc comes out from the disc slot.

### PS3: Remove Stuck Disc - PlayStation

In either case above, we recommend you to take out the tray out of the DVD player manually. a) Turn off the set and unplug the device from main power. b). Hold the set, do not turn over the set ( the top cover keeps facing upwards ). There is a hole below the bottom chassis. This hole is used to eject the tray manually. (See below to locate the hole.)
