Coding Clinic reiterates guidelines for provider ...

According to the ICD-9-CM Official Guidelines for Coding and Reporting, coders may report body mass index (BMI) and pressure ulcer stages based on medical record documentation from clinicians (e.g. nurses or dieticians) who are not the patient's provider (i.e., physician or other qualified healthcare practitioner legally accountable for establishing the patient's diagnosis).
