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Introduction To Morphology Linguistics

Morphology is the study of words. Morphemes are the minimal units of words that have a meaning and cannot be subdivided further. There are two main types: free and bound. Free morphemes can occur alone and bound morphemes must occur with another morpheme. An example of a free morpheme is "bad", and an example of a bound morpheme is "ly."

In biology and in geology morphology means the structures or forms of the body and the earth respectively. So, in linguistics also, morphology must refer to a study which is related to the forms of language. The most basic form of language is the word. Thus, we can say that morphology is the study of forms of words.

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To be more specific, morphology is the branch of linguistics that studies the formation of words and their internal structures.
