The Arabic verb forms. Most Arabic words are derived from a three-letter (trilateral) root. And each trilateral Arabic root can theoretically be transformed into one of fifteen possible verb forms (أفعال, al-awzaan).(Forms 11 through 15 are very rare, so people usually just focus on forms 1 through 10, although 9 is also pretty rare).

The root form of a verb is used to create other forms of the verb when conjugated. This is always true with regular verbs, but may not apply with irregular verbs, depending on ...
